# September Magazine Picks

Allen, Isabel. "Reciprocal House". Architecture Today. (No 332, July/August 2024). p.16-30.

"The sense of tranquility when I first entered the house was very real and palpable. It should be a given these days, but sustainability is also very quietly at the heart of this project. The house is well-insulated and airtight. It uses an air source heat pump for heating and has eliminated the use of gas on site. Passively, it benefits from solar gain in the winter when the surrounding trees are barren and form natural shading in the summer when the surrounding tree are in full leaf. Openable windows and an openable roof light over the spiral stair aid natural ventilation throughout the year. Green roofs, low water usage measures, and grey water recycling are also in place" (27).

Anaya, Suleman. "Muelle de San Blas San Blas, Mexico Colectivo C733". *The Architectural Review.* (July/August, 2024). p.98-107.

"Few would expect to find a well-designed and functioning let alone inviting and eye-catching contemporary structure in the municipality of San Blas. Located in the western Mexican state of Nayarit on the northern edge of Matanchen Bay, the fishing town of under 50,000 inhabitants appears stuck in time – charming, colorful and with a proud sense of its past, but also sleepy and decidedly untrendy, clearly missing out on the prosperity that can be found further down the Pacific coast in the booming resort towns near Puerto Vallarta" (100).

Bayhan, Bahar. "Good Housing Practices Around the World". *Volume 65: Living Together.* (Archis 2024 #1). p.16-17.

"Although housing is a fundamental human right, how it is perceived has been a shift in focus from fulfilling basic needs and use value to a kind of privilege that has become a financialized commodity where exchange value comes to the fore. Furthermore, that state of the current housing situation has been exacerbated by global crises such as epidemics, climate change, disasters, and poverty. People are facing displacement and homelessness around the world. Despite this seemingly bleak picture, there are many practical, innovative, and sustainable solutions to housing at various scales. Here is a collection of inspiring projects that give us hope and show that housing is not just a roof, but a way of weaving life together" (16).

Brown, Francisco. "Primitive Specificity". Metropolis. (Products, 2024). p.96-99.

"The firm's studio space, the Mississippi Workshop, is a three-story prefabricated mass timber structure designed, developed, and built by WA (Waechter Architecture's) as a test bed for its in-house all-wood construction research. The building is the first commercial project in Oregon to use mass timber construction for all building components. Except for the sheathed metal exterior and the integrated radiant concrete

flooring, the firm use exposed wood for all surfaces, purposely avoiding hybrid systems. "The idea with this building was to do a modern and high-tech building, but also a primitive one," says the firm's founding partner Ben Waechter" (96).

Dan Gordon Landscape. "Apple House". *Traditional Building*. (Vol 37, No 4, August 2024). p.34-36.

"From the outset, our goal was to renovate the property for contemporary living while preserving and enhancing the established character of the property," says landscape architect and firm Dan Gordon. "To meet the design challenge of creating a landscape that would contribute to the established sense of place, the design preserves existing resources, including mature vegetation, iron fencing, and granite walls and stairs at the entry garden. The style of the entry garden, the most formal of the three, is in keeping with the historic neighborhood and property. Clean and classic, the garden preserves the existing magnolia tree, a signature of the neighboring Back Bay townhouses" (34-35).

Hickman, Matt. "RoundTrip". Architectural Record. (August 2024). p.74-79.

"Not just integrate into the environment, OLM also trends lightly on it. Joined by a nearly 162, 000-square-foot geothermal field located opposite the hotel, a 510-kilowatt-peak photovoltaic system—its 1, 200 panels span the rooftop—helps the property achieve energy self-sufficiency. The 126-probe geothermal system provided thermal control and water heating for all-electric building. As Steiner notes, the project's energy infrastructure, with its \$1.6 million price tags, will pay for itself in four to six years. Notably, OLM also has its own artesian well, allowing it to serve limited mineral water fresh from the source to guests" (74).

Jones, Lauren. "A Coworking Space Captures a Community's Creative Spirit". *Metropolis*. (Products, 2024). p.156-163.

"When you Google images of San Miguel de Allende historic buildings awash in a rainbow of colors are likely what you'll find. The UNESCO World Heritage Site is unsurprisingly enchanting, bringing in over million visitors annually. Yet gentrification has made some central spaces more affordable for expats and tourists than for its residents. To execute their vision, the team leaned into the spirit of adapting, recycling, and reusing, something well in line with the property, which the original homeowners informally built. This type of construction is typical in Latin America" (158-160).

Mollard, Manon. "Le Cent Quatre Paris, France Atelier Novembre". *The Architectural Review.* (July/Augus, 2024). p.36-47.

"The Majestic roof of Halle Aubervilliers spans 32m in width and culminates at 22m. An impressive mobile gantry crane (opposite) awaits its next use. To help address

the shortage of workspaces for artists in Paris, Le Cent Quatre hosts a programme of residencies in theatre, dance, circus, music, visual arts, etc. Artists' studios are mostly situated in the Halle Aubervilliers. The building's third courtyard provides access to administration" (45).

Murmuur architecten, Carton 123 architecten, AE-architecten. 世界建筑 *The World architecture; Shi Jie Jian Zhu.* (No 408. June, 2024). p.60-65.

"The design proposal retains and restores the warehouse in the center, as it is the most beautiful existing structure of the site. It will be a large, slender building standing perpendicular to the axis of the site. This former warehouse becomes the beating heart of the site with 4 ateliers/ polyvalent spaces where many community activities will take place. A large passage, open to the ridge, connects both sides of the park. From the warehouse, visitors will have an overview of a large part of the park. The architecture explores the possibilities of the boundary between inside and outside. Benches against the façade's timberwork proved space to meet under the spacious roof crossing. The transparent base enhances the view." (62-63).

SIURA Studio. 世界建筑 *The World architecture; Shi Jie Jian Zhu.* (No 408. June, 2024). p.84-95.

"The park was divided by a 714 m open drain which was heavily polluted due to unfiltered water runoff from the upstream catchment. During high storm events, the park is frequently flooded as climate change drastically affects the unpredicted rainfall. A key strategy to ensuring the waterways are appropriately designed through nature-based system to improve the hydraulic performance. The once highly polluted canal is now revitalized into an active waterway with climate-adaptive approach. The ecologically restored river, planted with riparian vegetation, improves water quality by filtering and cleansing surrounding run-off and enhancing the site's biodiversity" (84).

Voyles, Ben. "A New Olympic Village, Building for the 2026 Winter Games in Milan". *Urbanland.* (Vol 38. No 3. Summer, 2024). p.66-68.

"A happy post-Oylmpic future is not sure thing. Since the first Olympic Village was built for the 1932 Summer Olympics in Los Angeles, many host cities have been unable to convert their athlete dormitories into successful permanent facilities. "A lot of them haven't been successful in terms of being durable works of architecture that transcend their first use and become contributors to the place [where] they were built," said Colin Koop, a New York based design partner of Skidmore, Owings & Merrill (SOM), the lead architects for the Milan project" (66).
